As luck would have it, my American foodie friend Scotty would be in Monaco for Thanksgiving so I saw it as a sign and snagged seats at the lunch for Hubby, Scotty and I. Just to be on the safe side, I brushed up on the words to the Star Spangled Banner.

I seek out any opportunity I can to visit the magnificent Salle Empire even if it means just sticking my head in to take a look when it's empty. With it's luminescent gittrim, 6 metre high ceilings, and frescoes of naked and bare breasted women cavorting with various creatures, the décor is much more theatrical than its subdued neighbour, the 3-Michelin Star restaurant, Le Louis XV.
